Angela and Simone have been playing together since last December, when they met at Trinity College of Music in London in 2009. Both of them are taking BMus (Hons) Performance Studies course, and they are currently towards the end of their second year. They participate in Trinity College of Music Sinfonia, and they also have been involved in Copernicus Project in 2009. Away from college Angela and Simone are currently members of London Arts Orchestra. This concert is their first time to perform as a duo.

Angela was born in London and was raised in South Korea, Brunei Darussalam, and the UK. At the age of four, she started both violin and piano. From 2008, Angela studied violin with Richard Ireland at Trinity and she had masterclasses with Leonard Elschenbroich, Quan Wu, Alexander Sitkovetsky, members from the Sitkovetsky Trio, and Natalie Dick, from the Finzi Quartet.

Simone was born in Stockholm, Sweden and started to play the violin at the age of 6, studying with several teachers in Stockholm (among them Marc Power). In 2007 she moved to Cardiff, Wales to study with Yu Yasuroka at the Royal Welsh College of Music and from 2009, she transferred to Trinity College of Music to study with Diana Cummings. Whilst at the Royal Welsh College Simone participated in masterclasses with among others Lesley Hatfield (Leader of BBC NOW) and the Eroica Quartet.

Ben was born in Birmingham, and from an early age took an interest in music, learning the clarinet and violin at primary school. He started studying piano with Michael Jones at the age of ten. In 2009 he moved to London to study at Trinity College of Music with Christine Croshaw, where he has also been able to pursue chamber music interests with singers and instrumentalists.
